

# Enable advanced digi-tech services to each person of state: CM

**Jaipur:** CM Vasundhara Raje urged the youth to take initiatives so as to enable delivery of technologically advanced services to each man of the state, during the closing ceremony of Digifest at Udaipur on Sunday. She also asked them for assistance in the development of Rajasthan. Raje launched several technology-based initiatives by the government at Digifest.

**E-Mitra plus:** The minister launched an advanced level of the current E-Mitra scheme. She informed that the model is being adopted in sev-

eral ways by different states. There are about 300 e-Mitra platforms and about 45,000 E-Mitra kiosks now.

**Rajmail:** A free citizen email service, RAJMAIL, was also launched. RAJMAIL, an initiative by DoIT, Government of Rajasthan, is a vernacular emailing system, developed by xgenplus, which allows the user to create their email addresses in regional languages including Hindi. DoIT offered first email id of this service in Hindi @. to the chief minister.

**Start incubator Jaipur:** She also launched the iStart incubator centre, which was

soon have a start-up incubator. **Raj WiFi:** Free WiFi services will now be provided by the department. The services

will be provided at Udaipur's Girwa, Badgaon, and RNT hospital in the beginning.

It will then be taken forward to 10,000 rural and 5,000 urban areas of the state. Raje informed that the government is making an effort to promote self-governance in the state through acceptance of the digital technology.

**E-health records:** Services of records was inaugurated by providing e-health cards to three patients.

These services will allow the patients to save their health records digitally, making analysis easier for doctors.
